THUNDER WONDER chased the leaders in the first flight of horses four wide early, was under an all out drive four wide on the last turn, had the leaders in her sights entering the stretch and took the lead in the very late stages. TOO MANY close up to the pace three wide early, made a bid for the lead three wide on the last turn, took a brief lead at the furlong pole and was overtaken late by the winner. SWIFT SWORD was in close attendance to the leaders along the rail early, applied pressure to the pacemaker around the final turn and finished gamely along the inside but was no match for the top two. SWEET RUNNER held a narrow lead during the early portions of the race, was hooked on the final turn and weakened in the final furlong. STAR SUITE broke in a bit of a tangle, chased the leaders along the rail early, made a bid for the lead along the inside around the final turn and flattened out late. CORY'S COMET was outrun and posed no serious threat. GOLD FLORIDAYS raced in between rivals while chasing the leaders early and dropped back to the back of the pack at the three furlong pole.
