MIAMI MUSIC set the pace on the inside, turned back a bid from SHADE OF ALLEY in upper stretch and edged clear, driving. BATTLE CALL raced five wide early, chased four wide on the backside, came three wide into the lane and rallied outside. SHADE OF ALLEY chased in the two path between rivals, bid at the quarter pole, dueled with the winner and weakened. VIRGING ON STARDOM settled off the rail and gained mildly outside. KROM was bumped at the start, raced four wide early, then saved ground and tired. HARLAN'S POINT raced off the pace inside and did not factor. AGARICUS was outrun. DEWEST was bumped at the start, chased three wide and faded.
