QUIET GIANT brushed with ABSINTHE MINDED at the start, settled comfortably outside of DEBONAIR DARLING, took charge midway on the far turn, drew away and widened under brisk urging. PAYTON D'ORO tracked the leaders racing between rivals, moved up midway on the turn and finished well while never threatening the winner. ABSINTHE MINDED chased on the rail, raced between rivals on the far turn and rallied mildly for third. DEBONAIR DARLING set the pace and weakened. TESORO DE AMOR stumbled at the start, raced off the inside, came three wide into the lane and lacked a rally. CHAMPAGNE D'ORO chased three wide and gave way in upper stretch. CHECK POINT was outrun early, came wide and had no rally. BLIND DATE failed to respond.
