BOMBAST bobbed slightly at the start, saved ground into the turn, moved out and raced three wide into the stretch then finished gamely to prevail. KING HENRY saved ground and vied for command, dug in gamely during the stretch run and yielded grudgingly. PUT TO THE TEST battled for the lead and weakened late. CORNPIPER bobbed and broke in bumping a rival, stayed outside and lacked a response. RAGING SIX trailed while not far back, saved ground and lacked a stretch bid. TRIPPI'S CHARM bumped at the start, moved up through the early stages and vied for the lead three deep into the turn, chased on the bend then weakened and was eased up late.
