Footnotes

SWEEPING HOURS set the pace while well off the rail, took pressure from FIREBOURNE around the final turn, repelled that bid at the furlong pole and drew clear under a steady drive late. FIREBORNE stalked the winner while four wide early, made a bid for the lead just the flank of the winner on the last turn, was no match for the winner response inside the furlong pole but was the best of the balance. A THOUSAND STARS chased the leaders five wide early, was asked for his best three wide on the last turn and rallied late to gain the show awards. CYRUS VIRUS was close up to the pace along the rail, was roused on the final turn and hung badly late while drifting out badly late. BEAUTIFUL NITE showed no early speed and passed tired foes. COURTNEY'S STAR was squeezed at the start and was no a serious factor. ALPINE MIST chased three wide and tired. TELLMENOSECRETS faltered.
