**Footnotes**

SHADOW MARIE, unhurried through the backstretch, started her bid into the final turn, assumed the lead at the sixteenth pole after a strong drive and was inching away the closing yards. CANDLELIGHTDINNER rated off the pace about the four path, was nearly even with the front runners three wide at the quarter pole, dug in gamely through the stretch but reluctantly yielded the final yards. AMALIA rated the pace two deep and between horses on the backstretch, was pressured for more into the final turn, moved clear entering the stretch but weakened with a sixteenth to go. INDIAN PINK rated with the pace inside, steadied from a tight spot on the rail into the final turn, recovered some momentum angling three wide entering the lane and finished evenly. JOMARKEL rated off the early pace about the three path, steadied from between horses into the final turn then finished evenly. FLEET SWEET rated with the early pace three deep, duelled to a short brief lead between horses into the final turn then leveled off through the stretch. TRULY ELEGANT showed no speed off the rail then no rally. TOUGH GAL dropped back inside and never factored. LUHUK'S TEMPER lost contact into the backstretch.
