CANARY DIAMOND vied outside, took over on the backside, dueled inside on the far turn and dug in gamely to prevail after a long drive. GOLD COLLECTION stumbled at the start, raced three wide, rallied three wide past the quarter pole and finished gamely outside. INDIAN BLOSSOM saved ground in the early stages, raced between rivals, chased on the turn and rallied mildly. CALYPSO QUEEN chased outside a rival, raced four wide on the backside, bid on the turn and tired. ALMOST GRECIAN was outrun early and did not factor. LED ADVANTAGE raced off the pace inside, came three wide into the lane and had no rally. NIGHT PEARL vied inside and tired.
