CASS bumped hard heading into the clubhouse turn, advanced three wide entering the far turn and challenged for the lead in the stretch then finished gamely to prevail. MISS NEPAL came out bumping a rival heading into the clubhouse turn, was steadied briefly inside on the final bend, moved around a rival in upper stretch and finished gamely back inside. SHAHADAROBA vied early and drew clear nearing the backstretch, showed the way to the lane and yielded grudgingly. RACYN WITH GRACYN lodged a bid outside on the final turn, raced four wide into the lane then also finished gamely while between rivals at the wire. EMMA HAMILTON trailed early and just off the rail turning for home, moved inside and gradually gained. SPLENDORED THING near the rail into the far turn, raced four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed bid. OUTWARD APPEARANCE broke slowly, raced in the three path into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. CRAVING CHOCOLATE broke a bit awkwardly, raced four wide passing the quarter pole and lacked a bid. MY POWER BULLET was bumped hard while three wide into the clubhouse turn, raced forwardly placed until nearing the top of the lane and tired. CECILIA'S SONG vied early then tracked, chased on the final turn and weakened through the lane. PERFECT JOY raced four wide into the clubhouse turn, stayed off the

inside and weakened into the far turn. POETIC LANA raced well placed to the far turn and tired.
