K. R.'S JAZZ tracked early, was asked on the turn, reached the front nearing the sixteenth pole and held gamely to the wire. BELIEVE IN DANCING always a factor and three wide turning for home, finished gamely. READYBDANCING raced four wide turning for home and finished willingly while needing more. CIRCULAR RHYTHM set the pave and battled into midstretch then weakened late. JUST DO IT PLEASE raced near the rail on the turn and lacked the needed late response. RIDE OUT THE STORM raced outside on the turn and lacked a rally. BLUES HEIR chased inside and tired in the drive. P J HOOKER lacked a rally. VANDALAYINDUSTRIES in just a bit close at the start, lacked a response.
