EASTERN GALE rated off the early pace off the rail, moved to the lead nearing the final turn then opened up steadily through the stretch, ridden out. OLIVIA JO, unhurriedly early, bid off the rail on the final turn then dueled for place. RIDGE COURT LADY bobbled slightly at the start, raced unhurriedly inside, eased out for the drive and finished evenly on the rail. CHARMING ATTITUDE dropped back entering the backstretch, improved her position angling widest on the final turn then proved empty in the drive. PRIVY kept off the pace outside, bid five wide on the final turn then proved empty in the stretch. DR. PIPER set the early pace in hand and off the rail, appeared to take a bad step nearing the final turn and was not abused after. CAN'T YOU SEE kept off the early pace in the three path then tired. GOODBYE PAST was outrun.
