FLEET VALID, prompted the early issue, moved to the front on the turn then responded gamely in the drive while drawing clear. ON THE VINEYARD close up early and three wide, finished gamely while clear for the place. MAKE ME ZACH between rivals into the turn, raced just off the rail to the stretch and earned the show. IDIOT PROOF set the early pace, saved ground and weakened in the drive. LANTANA MOB broke a bit slowly, saved ground into the turn, moved out turning for home and lacked the needed response. MISSILE MOTOR four deep into the turn, raced five wide into the stretch and lacked a bid. CASSOULET chased four wide and tired in the drive. DEVEREUX three wide and between foes into the turn, lacked a rally.
