SPANISH LULLABY rated a pressured pace two deep and held on well with steady encouragement. LUCY VALENTINE rated close three wide, took aim on the winner into the turn, couldn't catch that one but held on well for place. ACQUILEIA pressured the pace from the inside, continued in a solid drive from the top of the stretch but was leveling off toward the wire. MAMBO WITH G exchanged light contact with Sea Pines early, picked up the chase from off the rail, eased four wide into the lane and finished well. MAGIC SKIER gave chase five wide and finished evenly. SISTER SILVER was shuffled back early and no factor after. TOWER OF PISA appeared to be climbing early and showed no speed toward the outside. SEA PINES was re-saddled behind the gate, exchanged light contact with Mambo With G early, chased the pace about the three path, bore out entering the turn and came back with the saddle slipped back.
