UNWRITTEN vied outside, took over turning for home, drew clear and held well under urging. AFTERNOON TREAT chased inside, came three wide into the lane and finished gamely outside. HOBBITONTHEROCKS was bumped at the start, raced off the pace and rallied mildly outside. CAUSE I CAN was bumped at the start, chased outside and weakened. SEVENTY NINER vied inside and tired. FLIRTATIOUS SMILE saved ground to no avail. QUEPOS was impeded soon after the start by HELLO HANDSOME, stumbled and lost the rider. HELLO HANDSOME veered in sharply at the start and lost the rider. After a Stewards' Inquiry into the start, the race was declared official.
