JULIA SINGING BEAR rated off the pace toward the inside, eased outside the pacesetter nearing the quarter pole, entered the stretch in the four path then sustained a long drive to catch the leader, dueled gamely from the sixteenth pole and edged ahead the final strides. TYNE rated a short lead in the three path, drew clear under pressure entering the stretch, picked up the winner a sixteenth out and was outfinished the final strides. ASSESS rated off the pace in the four path, bid through the final turn and finished evenly. LIFTING THE VEIL, unhurriedly while never far back, bid inside on the final turn then proved empty in the drive. TREASURE'S DREAM was roughed into the opening turn, settled into stride off the rail, came evenly through the final turn in the three path, eased out for the drive then leveled off. HONORABLE FEELINGS was kept back toward the inside and offered no rally. AMERICAN CHALLENGE showed brief early speed then gave way. BOMBAY BLUES steadied briefly at the start, ran out into the opening turn, advanced to contention outside on the backstretch, gave chase through the final turn then faded into the stretch.
