SIX PACK SALLY was well placed on the inside, angled out three wide and finished willingly to earn the place award. GLOWING BREEZE raced off the rail and finished gamely outside to just miss second. OUR MARIAH saved ground, was in tight between rivals in the stretch, came through and finished well. THIRD COLLECTION rallied mildly. PAPER MOUNTAIN raced inside and failed to respond. FOLLOW ME HOME chased outside and tired. HOME RUN HITTER vied inside for the lead and gave way in the stretch. DEACON LAKE vied between rivals and faded.
