MELODY OF COLORS was kept close off the rail, bid entering the stretch and was clear leaving the sixteenth pole. OUR MARIAH chased the pace about the three path, was steadied lacking room into the turn, steadied while in tight between horses at the quarter pole, closed for place and finished well. OUT OF THE WILL showed no early speed off the rail, lacked room approaching the quarter pole, eased out into the lane and finished well. DESIRABLE MOMENT advanced to the lead and took up position off the rail when clear, showed the way to late stretch but had nothing left the final sixteenth. KISS ME KATIE chased the pace from the inside then weakened entering the lane. IN TOO DEEP chased the pace from the outside and proved empty in the stretch. GO GO BABY GO was steadied and became unsettled at the start, advanced to contention outside then had nothing left in the lane.
