WILD AND PROUD rated off the pace about the three path, moved to threaten three wide on the final turn, dueled gamely through the stretch and pulled clear toward the wire. GRAND CONSEQUENCE rated a short lead two deep, contested a slight advantage on the final turn, dug in gamely through the stretch then reluctantly yielded the last sixteenth. COSMO QUEEN rated with the early pace inside, gave chase into the final turn and finished evenly off the rail. TEASE showed no speed inside, advanced angling outward on the final turn and finished well outside. SATURNALIA angled toward the inside nearing the opening turn, kept in position through the backstretch, advanced mid track approaching the quarter pole then showed no further response in the stretch. FIDDLERS TRICK showed no speed outside and no rally. CHI HORI kept off the pace inside and faded on the final turn. BLESS YOU was jostled at the start, shuffled back into the first turn and outrun after.
