BRITELITEINTHECITY raced off the pace, came three wide into the lane, closed well outside and was just up for the win. TWELVE STONE stalked outside, bid three wide midway on the turn, drew clear in midstretch and was nailed on the wire. WRITE A SONG vied inside and stayed on well to the end. FIFTH AVE FANCY saved ground racing off the pace and closed belatedly inside. MYTHICAL MAN raced off the pace, made a four wide run on the far turn and flattened out. NATURAL TWENTY vied outside and tired. SECURITY ANALYSIS settled off the rail, between rivals, steadied at the quarter pole and failed to respond. PLEIADIAN did not factor. MIGHT COULD chased inside and faded. A Jockey's Objection by the rider of SECURITY ANALYSIS against the winner was dismissed.
