NO PLAY pressed the pace, bid on the turn, gained a short lead, responded and drew clear, driving. HOLY SMOKE tracked inside and finished well on the rail. BATTER UP raced between foes, came three wide into the lane and rallied mildly outside. CHORAL SOCIETY chased three wide, bid three wide on the turn and weakened. EXETER ROAD raced inside and had no rally. VALLEY STREAM raced off the pace, inside on the far turn and lacked a rally. KING HENRY set the pace on the inside and gave way on the far turn. INDY TUNE raced three wide early and faded.
