GOOMBADA GUSKA raced off the pace inside, rallied four wide into the stretch and drew clear late. HERMOSILLO dueled inside, dug in gamely in upper stretch and came up second best. BYTHEBEAUTIFULSEA raced off the pace inside, angled out at the top of the lane and rallied mildly. AT THE DISCO bobbled at the break, stalked two wide, bid three wide at the quarter pole and weakened. ADDUCE raced off the pace and gained mildly inside. THEMANNYTHNLEGEND bobbled at the break, raced three wide early and was outrun. CLEAR FAITH raced off the pace, moved up inside on the far turn and failed to respond. BROKEN TRAIL dueled outside, gave way and stopped.
