REFUGE stalked the leader, bid entering the far turn, took charge and drew away. IRISH EDDIE K was bumped at the start, raced off the pace between foes, finished well and was clear for the place. WIDE OPEN ROAD stalked outside and rallied mildly. DEAD MONEY raced three wide on the backside and lacked a late response. STRAIGHT NO CHASER chased inside and tired. EXPLOIT'S KID pulled his way along in the early stages, set the pace and gave way. SLOVAN was bumped at the start and did not factor. THIRD OF JULY was bumped at the start, raced inside and failed to threaten.
