POWERS PROSPECT set the pace on the inside, kicked clear entering the stretch and was driving to the wire. ENOUGH KISSIN was rated on the inside, responded when roused and won the battle for second. UPHILL SKIER pressed the pace racing in the two path, bid on the turn and then was outfinished for the place. PICNIC THEME raced between foes on the first turn, then three wide at the quarter pole and lacked a rally. SPECIAL AMERICAN raced inside and failed to respond. FIRECARD chased three wide and tired. CIGNO D'ORO saved ground and showed little. SALINA'S GIFT did not factor. SOMEONES COMING was outrun .
