BAR FLY rated a short lead off the rail, moved clear in the three path on the final turn then widened the last furlong under mild urging. JESSI J rated off the pace in mid track, bid in the four path of the final turn, had aim entering the stretch then drifted in giving chase. TREASURE'S DREAM ran outside the opening turn, showed no speed outside, saved some ground rounding the final turn then finished evenly toward the rail. STRICT FORUM raced unhurriedly, bid angling out nearing the quarter pole, was widest entering the stretch and finished evenly outside. FINISH 'EM OFF rated with the pace in the four path, drifted slightly out nearing the quarter pole then weakened in the drive. STORMY CONQUEST was shuffled back early, ran outside the opening turn, stayed just off the pace, was widest giving chase through the final turn then weakened. SHE DID IT HER WAY advanced to contention on the inside through the backstretch, faded saving ground the final turn then weakened and drifted out late. SPLASHING ROSE bobbled slightly at the start, rated off the pace in the three path and was through early.
