TOWER OF PISA advanced to a clear lead nearing the three quarters pole, maintained position under a firm hold on the backstretch, meted her speed through the final turn then dug in gamely to persevere. RINELLA STORM settled back inside, started her drive off the rail into the final turn, checked on the heels of the winner while angling inside that one entering the stretch then remained close to the wire. PREVENTION rated back off the rail, bid four wide into the final turn, eased out for the drive then drifted back in finishing well and just getting show. REAL MEMORIES kept off the pace toward mid track, bid into the final turn, was nearly on even terms while six wide at the quarter pole, showed no significant response in midstretch and finished on her own courage. WILD AND PROUD showed no speed inside, angled out leaving the quarter pole and passed tiring rivals widest. AEROCAT rated close two deep, contested the final turn, was forced out checking leaving the quarter pole and gave way from there. SMARTGABRIELLE showed no speed inside, bid mildly on the rail at the quarter pole then gave way in the lane. WITHLAPATIENCE rated close inside, faded through the final turn then eased in the stretch.
