Footnotes

ONE NEAT CAT broke in bumping RICKYONTHERUN at the start, chased between rivals, bid three wide on the turn, surged late in the three path and got the nod in a driving finish. RICKYONTHERUN was bumped at the start, outrun early, advanced inside, angled out in upper stretch, closed well late outside and just missed. CALLIPYGIAN DREAM chased two wide, bid between foes turning for home, took a short lead and dug in gamely between rivals. CALDRON set the pace racing of the rail and stayed on well inside through the stretch. COPPERHEAD SLINGER raced close up inside and finished evenly. J'S KING'S RANSOM failed to respond. BINGHAM HILL raced four wide on the backside and gave way.
