PAT'S DILEMMA bobbed slightly a few strides from the gate, advanced to a short lead toward the inside, rated his speed to the top of the lane, briefly lost control midstretch but dug in gamely to recover and was inching away through the final sixteenth. BACK IN BALTIMORE rated close to the pace two deep, dueled to a short brief lead in midstretch then grudgingly yielded passing the sixteenth pole. SMOKEY FELLA rated off the pace about the three path, gave chase through the turn then leveled out in the drive. THE CROONER chased the pace toward the outside, entered the stretch six wide and proved empty in the drive. FISHERTHEFIRECHIEF was outrun in the three path. MASTER SALESMAN, edgy in the paddock, was briefly unsettled after breaking a step slow then steadied near the rail while at the flanks of Atthesale inside the opening sixteenth. DOCTOR GARRETT chased the early pace widest and faded saving some ground on the turn. ATTHESALE chased the early pace inside then lost some ground and weakened into the lane.
