UNCLE GARE tracked inside, came through on the rail turning for home and drew clear under urging. JUST FOOLIN AROUND was off a bit slow and steadied, raced off the pace, angled out in upper stretch and made a late run outside. MR. BESILU saved ground racing off the pace and rallied mildly inside. INGENUITY stalked two wide, bid midway on the far turn and rallied mildly between foes. IRON WORKS raced four wide early, continued three wide and lacked a bid while inside through the stretch. ENDORPHINS FLY set the pace and weakened. NO ITS NOT raced off the pace, between foes and tired.
