RAISE THE CODE was off a bit slow and bumped at the break, moved up quickly into contention on the turn, rallied three wide into the stretch and drew out. TOP NOTCH BUDDY vied inside, chased on the turn and finished well. TROPONIN raced inside was caught in traffic midway on the turn, angled out in upper stretch and made a late run outside. VICTORY TEAM chased four wide and lacked a winning bid. TIMBER WEST showed good speed outside, cleared off and tired. MALIBU MYSTERY chased inside and tired. STRIKE DOWN raced inside, was steadied on the turn and lacked a rally. FIRE KING did not factor. MERCILESS CAT did not factor. WHO'S THE MAN chased three wide and faded. O B THE BEST was bumped at the start, raced inside, then between rivals and was steadied at the quarter pole while tiring.
