Footnotes

TASTEFULLY SMART broke open the gate prior, settled off the rail, moved up four wide on the backside, made a four wide run on the far turn, rallied outside and was going best late. UFFIZI stalked outside, bid three wide entering the far turn, took over and dug in gamely to the finish. ISITTRUEMOSSY was bumped at the start, raced off the pace inside, between foes on the backside, raced three wide on the far turn, was bumped between rivals turning for home and rallied mildly. CAFFE D' ORO tracked inside, was steadied sharply approaching the far turn, steadied again at the quarter pole and rallied mildly on the rail. GALAXY TAX was bumped at the start, raced three wide between rivals on the backside, moved up four wide on the turn and then was bumped and steadied at the quarter pole. BOLD STYLE dueled between rivals, weakened and was bumped and steadied at the quarter pole. BERNING BLAZE raced off the pace inside, moved up five wide on the far turn and flattened out. BLACK HAWK SOARING dueled three wide and tired. FIVE MILL dueled inside and tired.
