CAVIAR N CHAMPAGNE was off slow and stumbled after the start, raced off the pace, came four wide into the lane and rallied outside. SEASIDE MAGIC bobbled at the break, was outrun early and made a late run outside. DON SIX'S NUMBER was bumped at the start, vied outside, bid three wide on the turn and weakened. PEGGY JOYCE was bumped at the start, raced off the rail, was steadied at the quarter pole and lacked a rally. SWEET MOONBEAM was bumped at the start, vied between rivals and tired. SMOKIN GOLD was bumped at the start, tracked inside and faded.
