JUDITH'S SYMPHONY raced off the pace inside, advanced outside a rival, split foes nearing the quarter pole and drew clear, driving. DEACON DAN raced off the pace, advance on the far turn, rallied late inside and was up on the line for second. HALE AND HEARTY stalked the pace, bid two wide on the far turn and lose the place in the final jump. JERSEY A.J. set the pace, opened up a clear lead and weakened. BOND CHAMP was outrun early, came wide and rallied mildly outside. GONE PROSPECTING raced off the rail then three wide, bid four wide and tired. MR. W. B. raced inside and faded.
