Footnotes

NOWNOWNOW steadied in traffic and was shuffled back early after breaking slowly, tucked in along the rail while racing well in hand trailing for five furlongs, saved ground while well back behind a wall of horses to the turn, swung out nearing the quarter pole, circled six wide entering the stretch then closed strongly in the middle of the track under left hand urging to get up in the final fifty yards. ACHILL ISLAND (IRE) steadied sharply while in tight in the early stages, raced well back in traffic on the first turn, was outrun for five furlongs, moved out after checking in traffic on the far turn, steadily gained while five wide to reach contention in upper stretch, made a steady move to challenge a sixteenth out, gained a brief lead while dueling in deep stretch but couldn't hold the winner safe. CANNONBALL settled in good position while saving ground, angled out while gaining on the turn, made a run to threaten in upper stretch and finished willingly to gain a share. STRIKE THE DEAL raced in midpack while saving ground, stalked three wide on the far turn, advanced five wide behind horses nearing the quarter pole, angled to the rail in upper stretch and rallied mildly along the inside. DOMESTIC FUND (IRE) stalked the leaders while three wide to the top of the stretch, battled into upper stretch and weakened late. TEXAS FEVER steadied in traffic nearing the first turn, raced well back while four wide to the turn, steadied and altered course to the outside at the three-sixteenths pole and lacked a strong finishing bid. THE LEOPARD checked after breaking a bit slowly, rushed up inside, moved between horses nearing the backstretch, pressed the pace for six furlongs, advanced four wide on the turn, raced just off the pace into upper stretch and steadily tired thereafter. GIO PONTI steadied sharply in traffic through the opening quarter and failed to mount a serious rally thereafter. YOUR ROUND in tight early, saved ground along the backstretch, steadied along the inside while lacking room midway on the turn, swung out entering the stretch, steadied and drifted to the outside in upper stretch and lacked the needed response when called upon. PRUSSIAN bobbled at the start, rushed up to gain the early advantage, set the pace inside into upper stretch and faltered in the final eighth. CHEROKEE TRIANGLE checked in tight at the start, steadied in traffic in the early stages, raced between horses to the turn and lacked a further response. PREACHIN MAN checked in traffic through the first turn, steadied while lacking room along the inside on the far turn and failed to menace thereafter.
