Footnotes

WAR PASS sprinted clear along the rail, raced uncontested on the lead on the backstretch, extended his advantage on the turn, opened a comfortable lead in upper stretch and was never threatened while being kept to the task under steady left hand encouragement. PYRO fractious in the gate, was bumped at the start, checked between horses on the first turn, was unhurried for a half, moved around horses while gaining on the turn, angled three wide entering the stretch and finished willingly to clearly best the others. KODIAK KOWBOY steadied between horses on the first turn, chased the leaders four wide to the turn and lacked a strong closing bid. TALE OF EKATI angled to the rail on the first turn, raced evenly in midpack for six furlongs, lodged a mild bid on the turn and flattened out. Z HUMOR failed to mount a serious rally while saving ground. OLD MAN BUCK was outrun for six furlongs, circled six wide at the quarter pole and lacked a late response. OVEREXTENDED was shuffled back soon after the start and never reached contention. SHORE DO was never a factor. SALUTE THE SARGE drifted out on the first turn, and raced wide throughout while lacking a rally. WICKED STYLE was finished after going five furlongs while wide throughout. GLOBALIZATION stumbled and baced inward at the start , prompted the pace in the two path and gave way on the turn.
