GINGER PUNCH settled just off the pace while saving ground along the backstretch, moved through along the rail to challenge on the far turn, battled heads apart inside HYSTERICALADY leaving the quarter pole, was bumped off stride by that one while dueling inside the furlong marker then fought back gamely to prevail under left hand urging after a long drive. HYSTERICALADY pressed the pace in the two path to the top of the stretch, dug in from outside in upper stretch, drifted in to bump the winner in midstretch then yielded grudgingly. OCTAVE was outrun for six furlongs, rapidly closed the gap while saving ground midway on the turn, split rivals while rallying in upper stretch then closed steadily from outside but could not get up. LADY JOANNE chased the leaders three wide along the backstretch, raced just off the pace between horses into upper stretch and lacked a strong finishing bid. UNBRIDLED BELLE bobbled a few strides away from the gate and angled to the inside early, steadied along while lacking room on the rail for a half mile, moved out along the backstretch, made a sharp move to reach contention on the far turn, angled four wide while gaining at the quarter pole but couldn't sustain her bid. BALANCE saved ground for a good portion of the trip and lacked the needed response when called upon. TOUGH TIZ'S SIS was taken in hand early, angled three wide on the first turn, raced well back for six furlongs then passed mostly tiring horses. BEAR NOW set the pace in the two path to the turn and steadily tired thereafter. INDIAN VALE stalked the pace three wide along the backstretch, dropped back on the turn and faded in the stretch. LEAR'S PRINCESS bumped with TEAMMATE between horses on the first turn, was outrun for a half, steadied in traffic at the five-eighths pole, trailed on the turn and was never close thereafter. TEAMMATE, bumped on the first turn, was never a factor. PROP ME UP failed to mount a serious rally while between horses. Following a stewards inquiry into the stretch run there was no change in the order of finish.
