HOTNSLICK settled off the rail, moved up three wide on the turn and closed well outside for second. SMART FOREST chased four wide, bid on the turn and weakened late. GRACEFULLY MEAN chased three wide and failed to sustain a bid. OH RAMBLIN ROSE chased inside and tired. MO BOURBON PLEASE saved ground to no avail. MAGICAL FLAIR chased between rivals and faded. SENATOR BECK was outrun.
