BAI BAI DUBAI raced three wide into the first turn, stalked the pace, bid between rivals at the quarter pole, gained a short lead and held on well. PERKY JUGUE tracked the pace, bid three wide on the turn and came up second best. GOODLOOKINRED had a ground saving trip, angled out at the quarter pole and lacked a winning bid. CRAFTY WAYNE was off a bit slow, settled outside a rival and failed to threaten. STEAL A STAR set the pace and faded. STORM HOPE saved ground and did not factor.
