WELL POSITIONED pressed the pace, dug in determinedly between rivals and was all out to prevail on the wire. GONE ASTRAY raced three wide early, then saved ground, swung five wide passing the quarter pole and finished gamely outside. CHIRAC set the pace on the inside, responded when asked and dug in gamely to the finish. CACTUS CHARLIE tracked inside, then between rivals, made a bid on the rail and weakened. HOP SKIP AND AWAY raced between rivals, then three wide, made a bid and was outfinished. SUNSHINE RAMBLER had a three wide trip, swung six wide turning for home and faded. EVENINGS END raced inside and tired. AT THE DISCO made a three wide middle move to contest the pace and gave way.
