DANCE FASTER was well rated while racing in the middle of the pack between rivals, stalked the leaders to the second-last jump, moved strongly before the last jump to gain command in the upper stretch and drew off. CALL ME SONNY rated while racing on the outside, rallied strongly near the final fence, split the leaders wide in the stretch but couldn't gain on the winner. EMBARRASSED stalked the leaders through the first circuit, took command before the third-last jump, led over the last jump, went very wide into the stretch and weakened. FINAL STRAW was unhurried while racing in the middle of the pack through the first circuit, rallied to stalk the leaders after the third-last jump, looked like a strong force two jumps out, seemed to weaken before the last jump, then finishing willingly. SALUDA SAM quickly took command, dueled with BEER FRAME to the third-last jump, tired and stumbled at the last jump.. TRITON LIGHT rated in the middle of the pack and lacked a rally. THE EDITOR trailed. BEER FRAME pressed the early pace, dueled for the lead after the third jump and tired before the third-last jump.
