CHESTERMITE saved ground in mid pack through the first circuit advanced inside, took command nearing three furlongs out, vied inside between rivals and prevailed in a game effort. CLASS MARK disputed the early pace with KNIGHT IN ARMOUR past the halfway point, put that rival away but was soon joined by the winner, vied with that rival to mid stretch but was second best late. HOUGHTON REGRETS lacked speed, steadily advanced outside through the final half-mile and rallied for the show. LAST NOBLE settled behind the winner in early going, followed that rival's advance to reach contention nearing the lane then flattened out a bit in the drive. MESHWAAR failed to menace. DISTANT STRIKE was no threat. TIEFORDANCEN never factored. WHITE HOLIDAY was no factor. STRAIGHTREDCARD chased the pace, tired and was pulled up before the final fence. KNIGHT IN ARMOUR disputed the early pace, faltered and was pulled up before the final fence.
