RUSHLANA pressed the pace from three wide, bid and dueled, opened a lead in the upper stretch and held well. GONKALEY E R was slow early, raced three wide, gained ground steadily, rallied into the stretch and finished well. GENTLE SENORITA raced four wide early, stalked the pace, rallied three wide and gained ground. CRIME IS UP broke sharply, dueled to the outside but weakened in the upper stretch. MINT CHOCOLATE was caught five wide early, raced evenly, rallied three wide and gained ground late. SHANIA CAN stalked the pace on the rail, raced evenly but weakened in the turn and faded. PIPER'S DASH lacked early speed, raced evenly but was no factor. PUKIMNA saved ground, raced evenly and was never a threat. ROSEDEN ran close up on the rail but weakened in the turn and faded in the stretch.
