GRANITE POINT dueled on the rail, rallied into the upper stretch, dueled and prevailed. AUSTIN APPRENTICE made a bid entering the turn, dueled to the outside, rallied into the stretch but was outfinished. MAKIN IT COUNT was bumped at the start, gained ground steadily gain on the rail, chased the leaders and finished evenly. SIX PACK broke inward and bumped with MAKIN IT COUNT, chased the leaders to the outside and finished evenly. GO KURT GO lacked speed, raced evenly, rallied in the upper stretch and finished well. THE CON IS SMILES raced evenly from between rivals and showed a mild bit. FRENZY FUN raced evenly on the rail and was no threat. MY FRIEND TOM broke sharply, dropped back early and raced to the outside. SIR BOBBSY lacked speed, trailed, showed little.
