Footnotes

FREEQUARTERSMINE pressed the pace on the rail, was in tight at the quarter pole and was taken back, came again, rallied into the stretch and closed. SO WHATABOUT raced close up from three wide, gained ground steadily rallied three wide into the upper stretch and finished evenly. REMOVE raced evenly on the rail, chased the pace, rallied in the upper stretch and gained ground. SHADOW RUSH set a pressured pace, to the outside, opened a short lead in the turn, weakened into the stretch and failed to rally. BEN'S MAGIC was taken back early, raced evenly, rallied four wide and finished well. BOULDER HAT raced close up from three wide but weakened in the turn and faded. GARYS BUDDY saved ground, raced evenly and was never a factor. FIVE DE MAYO was in tight quarters on the rail entering the turn, had to be steadied and trailed.
