SPARHAWK broke well, raced four wide early, came in at the three eighths pole, rallied into the stretch, led in the upper and held well. FREEQUARTERSMINE pressed the pace on the rail, was in tight at the three eighths pole, dropped, stalked the pace but weakened and held place. BRED ROYAL contended on the rail, was caught in tight at the three eighths pole, dropped back and finished evenly. GREAT ANNOUNCER raced three wide early, was in tight at the three eighths pole, stalked the pace but weakened in the stretch. JACKMAN lacked speed, trailed, gained ground in the turn, rallied in the upper stretch and gained ground. KOOL ATLANTIC was slow early, raced evenly but dropped back in the turn. COOL REVELATION lacked speed, raced wide early, gained ground in the turn but gave way. THE RIDER ON BRED ROYAL CLAIMED FOUL ON SPARHAWK FOR INTERFERENCE AT THE THREE EIGHTHS POLE. THE CLAIM OF FOUL WAS UPHOLD AND SPARHAWK WAS DISQUALIFIED FROM FIRST AND PLACED FOURTH.
