SUNNY BREAK stalked the pace, made a bid in the backstretch, rallied into the upper stretch and closed well. OFFLEE FANCEE lacked speed, raced evenly, gained ground in the second turn, rallied and finished well. LINDSEY'S STORM broke sharply, dropped back on the rail and finished ran evenly. LEWISHAM dueled on the rail, weakened in the backstretch and dropped back. LOEN stalked evenly on the rail and faded in the stretch. BRED ROYAL stalked three wide, made a bid in the backstretch but weakened in the second turn and gave way
