Footnotes

CHARLESTOWN CHIEF raced three wide early, dueled to the outside of WIRED TWO TWENTY, rallied three wide and closed steadily. WIRED TWO TWENTY dueled on the rail, rallied into the stretch, came in through the stretch and was outfinished. FEEL THE MOMENT stalked the pace, made a bid on the rail in the upper stretch, was in tight quarters along the the rail and weakened. The rider on FEEL THE MOMENT claimed foul on WIRED TWO TWENTY for interference in the stretch. The claim of foul was upheld and WIRED TWO TWENTY was disqualified from second and placed third. DOUBLE SHUFFLE broke outward then drifted out in the first turn, gained ground, rallied 4 wide and finished well. BOURBON SHOOTER stalked the pace, raced evenly but weakened along the backstretch and dropped back. SILVER POLISH stalked the pace to the outside, entered the stretch four wide upper but faded. BE VEVEY VEVEY QUIET was three wide early, raced evenly and dropped back backstretch. START THE CAR was off slowly, trailed and was never a factor.
