Footnotes

FRIEDA'S GIRL set a pressured pace on the rail, assumed command in the second turn and drew clear. MAJESTIC ANA entered the first turn three, stalked the pace to the outside, raced evenly then rallied three wide into the stretch and prevailed for place. QUEEN'S QUEST was off slowly, entered the first turn three wide, gained ground from three wide, rallied five wide into the stretch and finished well. CASCADE PARK pressed the pace to the outside but weakened in the second turn and finished evenly. DASHIN' KIRI was four wide in the first turn then drifted out, continued to stalk in the backstretch, made a bid three wide in the second turn but faded in the stretch. WESTERN REMARK was slow early, raced evenly but dropped back in the second turn. SANDSURFER raced evenly from between horses but weakened in the backstretch and gave way.
