GIN FIZZ gaining ground from three wide, rallied three wide, closed steadily and drew clear late. JUST THE CASH stalked the lead, made a bid in the turn, rallied into the upper stretch, altered course to the outside and closed. BOLDEST MAX broke well to set the pace but weakened in the upper stretch and faded. COAST TO COAST BOB stalked the pace on the rail, was caught in tight turn in the turn and was steadied then rallied four wide and gained ground. BIG JON TAYLOR lunged at the start, raced three wide, gained ground in the turn, rallied four wide and finished well. JIFFY DANCER was off slowly, saved ground but weakened. LUCKY LITTLE GUY broke well, dropped back early and was no factor. IZZY FORREAL raced between rivals early, dropped back in the turn and show a mild rally. BIG EDDY lunged at the start, trailed and was never a factor.
