MEETMEAT TIFFANYS dueled on the rail, opened a lead in the upper stretch and drew clear. GITTER DONE GIRL raced evenly on the rail, gained ground in the second turn, rallied and held place. KEYANO raced four wide into the first turn, stalked the pace, rallied three wide but faded in the stretch. BETT ON RUTHIE was slow early, ran evenly and showed a mild rally. DRIVEN BY SEATTLE chased the pace, ran evenly but weakened in the second turn and faded. ANN CAN chased the pace early, dropped back in the backstretch and trailed. FAME FOREST dueled to the outside but weakened in the backstretch and gave way.
