GOLD WINNER stalked the pace on the rail, raced evenly, rallied three wide in the upper stretch and closed well. RATTLE THE CAGE vied three wide, made a bid in the second turn, led into the stretch but weakened. JUST THE CASH raced evenly on the rail, rallied three wide and finished well. CASANOVA KING raced four wide into the first turn, ran evenly, gained ground in the backstretch but faded. OVERBAY vied between rivals but weakened in the backstretch and dropped back in the stretch. YANKEE COLONEL lacked speed, saved ground, rallied in the upper stretch and gained in the stretch. NINE O'CLOCK GUN broke sharply, raced wide, made a bid in the backstretch but flattened out in the stretch. SKID was slow early, ran evenly but gave way and, trailed. WOULD I WOULD I raced evenly to the outside, gained in the second turn, rallied four wide but faded. GENERAL RULE broke well, vied on the rail but gave way in the second turn.
