Footnotes

JUKEBOX JACK stalked three wide, gained ground in the second turn, bid in the upper stretch, dueled and prevailed. OGLETHORPE stalked the pace, ran evenly, rallied into the upper stretch and closed steadily. SALTON CHIEF rushed to contend, dueled on the rail, led in the backstretch, rallied but weakened in the stretch. BO'S TIGER lacked speed, raced evenly, rallied three wide and finished well. BILLYREA saved ground, ran evenly, rallied into the upper stretch and finished well. DAZZLING FRONTIER was in tight early, trailed and passed tiring rivals. JOSHUA JET FUEL saved ground, stalked the pace but weakened in the second turn and dropped back in the stretch. NOTIS THE CRIME lacked speed, raced three wide into the first turn and was never a factor. ENOUGH EH rushed to contention, dueled to the outside but weakened in the backstretch and gave way.
